## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 3, 2009 the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety (NTIPS) Director filed a Complaint against Houlton Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Guaranteed Phone Service, (Respondent) seeking to fine Respondent on the grounds that it failed to file the required remittance worksheet or remittance payment by the 15<sup>th</sup> day following the end of the remittance period pursuant to section 003.02 and/or section 003.03 of Title 291, Neb. Admin. Rules & Regs. Chapter 10.

Respondent subsequently ceased to do business in Nebraska and filed an application with the Commission to cancel its certificate of authority in Nebraska that was subsequently granted by the Commission on May 18, 2010. Upon review of the facts and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the Complaint should be dismissed.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the complaint in the above-captioned docket against Houlton Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Guaranteed Phone Service, be, and is hereby, dismissed.
