O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On September 28, 2010, the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety (NTIPS) Director filed a Complaint against CenCom, Inc., (Respondent) seeking to fine Respondent on the grounds that it failed to file the required remittance worksheet or remittance payment by the 15th day following the end of the remittance period pursuant to section 003.02 and/or section 003.03 of Title 291, Neb. Admin. Rules & Regs. Chapter 10.

Respondent has requested a waiver, as the above-captioned complaint was the first complaint filed against the Respondent for late-filed NUSF remittances. Pursuant to the Commission Late-filed Remittance Policy and Procedures, the Respondent is eligible for a one-time waiver and NTIPS recommends the administrative fines and penalties be waived and the complaint dismissed. Upon review the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the NTIPS Department recommendation should be approved and the Complaint should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the complaint against CenCom, Inc., be, and is hereby, dismissed.
