## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On January 29, 2013, the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety (NTIPS) Director filed a Complaint against IPFA/Farm Bureau Connection, (Respondent) seeking to fine Respondent on the grounds that it failed to file the required remittance worksheet or remittance payment by the 15<sup>th</sup> day following the end of the remittance period pursuant to section 003.02 and/or section 003.03 of Title 291, Neb. Admin. Rules & Regs. Chapter 10.

On August 20, 2013, the Commission sustained a complaint in an unrelated matter, revoking the authority of the Respondent and imposing administrative fines pursuant to its authority. Therefore, the Department recommends the complaint be dismissed. Upon review the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the Department recommendation should be approved and the Complaint should be dismissed.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the complaint against IBFA/Farm Bureau Connection, be, and is hereby, dismissed.
