## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On June 1, 2005, Jeffrey L. Pursley, Director of the Nebraska Universal Service Fund (NUSF) Department of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) (hereinafter "Complainant") filed the above-captioned Complaint against CommSouth Companies, Inc. (hereinafter "Respondent") alleging that Respondent failed to file the required remittance worksheets or remittance payments to the NUSF Department by the 15th day following the end of the remittance period.

A copy of the Complaint was mailed to the Respondent, by certified mail, on June 22, 2005 and again on July 21, 2005.

A hearing on the Complaint was set for December 6, 2005. At that time it was made known to the Commission that Respondent had filed a Chapter 7 bankruptcy petition and was liquidating The Commission continued the hearing until a date its assets. later to be determined. Respondent had also filed a request to cancel its certificate of public convenience and necessity which was granted on December 20, 2005 in Application No. C-3483. Subsequently, Respondent notified the Commission that it had completely providing dissolved and was no longer telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska. Based on these circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the above-captioned complaint should be dismissed.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the above-captioned complaint be and it is hereby dismissed.
