The Commission, on its own motion, opened this docket to review the proposed basic local exchange rate increase portion of companies' transition plans and to prescribe fair, just and reasonable basic local exchange rates for ILECs in the state of Nebraska who have requested the Commission to prescribe such rates pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. sec. 86-803(4).

On March 14, 2000, this Commission entered Progression Order #2 setting a hearing for June 27, 2000, for the purpose of receiving testimony on any revised basic local exchange rate increases contained in amended transition plans. However, subsequent events require the Commission to continue said hearing. As a result, the hearing in said matter will be on June 29, 2000, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.
