BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

By application filed February 5, 2009, Dalton Telephone Company (Dalton) and Elsie Communications (Elsie) jointly filed an application seeking a waiver of the state universal service fund mechanism (NUSF) established in NUSF-26 and amended in part by the Commission's orders in the above-captioned docket. Notice of the waiver request was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on February 9, 2009. No protests or interventions have been filed.

The Commission hearing on the Dalton and Elsie waiver request will be held on April 14, 2009 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium Building, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska. Counsel for Elsie and Dalton and the Commission staff have agreed upon a procedural schedule for pre-filing testimony and exhibits at the hearing. According to this agreement, pre-filed testimony and exhibits will be concurrently filed on April 1, 2009 and reply testimony and exhibits will be filed on April 8, 2009.
