By application filed August 27, 2008, Long Lines Wireless LLC (Long Lines) of Sergeant Bluff, Iowa requests Nebraska universal service fund support for wireless telecommunications services. Notice of the application appeared in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on August 29, 2008. Petitions of Formal Intervention were filed by the Rural Independent Companies and by United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a Embarq.
