BY THE COMMISSION:

By Application filed February 1, 2012, CenturyLink seeks Nebraska Broadband Pilot (NEBP) Program support. Notice of the Application appeared in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on February 7, 2012.

Upon review of the application, the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety (NTIPS) Department determined that CenturyLink should supplement and/or clarify its application with additional information. The NTIPS Department has contacted CenturyLink with a request to supplement and clarify the information contained in its application.

The Commission does not anticipate that the supplemental filings will alter or enlarge the application in a manner which would require re-publication. However, the Commission wants to ensure that the applicant has a sufficient opportunity to comply with the Department's request. In addition, the Commission finds it appropriate to provide a sufficient opportunity for interested persons to determine their interest in this proceeding based upon the supplemented application. Accordingly, the Commission finds that the protest and intervention deadline should be extended to March 26, 2012. Interested parties will now have until **March 26, 2012** to file petitions of Formal Intervention or Protest with the Commission and effectuate service thereof upon the applicant and any other interested parties.
