On February 1, 2012, CenturyLink filed four applications for support under the Nebraska Broadband Pilot (NEBP) Program. Notice of the applications appeared in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on February 7, 2012.

On March 15, 2012, the Commission received a letter from CenturyLink requesting to withdraw its application in part, with regard to service in the Elkhorn area. This withdrawal does not affect CenturyLink's other applications for Alliance (Rainbow Acres), Sidney (Sioux Meadows), Gretna (Thousand Oaks), and Omaha (Calhoun).

Based upon this letter, the Commission finds CenturyLink's request should be granted and the application related to the Elkhorn area is withdrawn.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that CenturyLink's application for support under the Nebraska Broadband Pilot Program for service to the Elkhorn area be, and it is hereby, withdrawn.
