By Petitions filed on April 5, 2013, and pursuant to Neb. Admin. R. Regs. tit. 291, ch. 1, sec. 015, Cox Nebraska Telcom, LLC ("Cox") Great Plains Cable Television, Inc. ("Great Plains", the United States Cellular Corporation ("US Cellular") and N.E. Colorado Cellular d/b/a Viaero Wireless ("Viaero") seek formal intervention in the above-captioned proceeding. Also, on April 5, 2013, pursuant to Neb. Admin. R. Regs. tit. 291, ch.1, sec. 014, a Protest was timely filed by Charter Communications, Inc. ("Charter").

Based on the statements made by the above-named companies in their respective Petitions, I am of the opinion and find that the Petitions for Formal Intervention should be granted. Charter having filed a Protest in this matter shall also be considered a party consistent with the Commission's Rules of Procedure.
