OPINION AND FINDINGS

By Application filed November 26, 2014, Glenwood Telecommunications, Inc. ("Glenwood") sought Nebraska Broadband Pilot (NEBP) Program support. Notice of the Application appeared in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on December 4, 2014.

On July 21, 2015, the Commission granted the application of Glenwood. The Commission's approval authorized the construction of one broadband project referred to as the "Sutton" project. One of the eight conditions in the Commission's Order required the project to be completed within twenty-four (24) months from the date of the July 21, 2015, Order, unless otherwise extended by the Commission.

On July 10, 2017, Glenwood filed a request for an extension of time. In support of its request, Glenwood stated they experienced a delay of about eighteen months due to difficulties with connectivity between leased fiber at Sutton and Glenwood's constructed to the tower. Glenwood requests complete tower and additional time to work installations. Accordingly, Glenwood requested an extension to December 31, 2017.

In consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds an extension of time should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the July 10, 2017, request for extension of the deadline filed by Glenwood shall be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Glenwood shall have until December 31, 2017, to complete the Sutton project.
