Background

By Application filed November 26, 2014, Pinpoint Communications, Inc. ("Pinpoint") seeks Nebraska Broadband Program ("NEBP") support. Notice of the Application appeared in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on December 4, 2014.

A staff recommendation was filed on May 11, 2015. No pre-filed testimony was filed for Pinpoint.

On July 6, 2015, the Commission held a public hearing on the application in Lincoln, Nebraska. For administrative efficiency, the hearing was consolidated with the hearings in NUSF-92.17, NUSF-92.19, NUSF-92.21, NUSF-92.23 through NUSF-92.26 through 92.30, NUSF-92.33, and NUSF-92.35 through NUSF-92.40.

The Commission staff analyzed each project including the project filed by Pinpoint. Although the Pinpoint project was eligible, the Staff Recommendation did not include funding for the Pinpoint project as the NEBP support for the current year had been exhausted. No testimony was offered at the hearing in support of the Pinpoint application or in opposition to the Staff Recommendation. The Commission encourages Pinpoint to re-file its broadband application in subsequent rounds for support.

O R D E R




