By Motion filed on February 9, 2015, and pursuant to Neb. Admin. R. & Regs., title 291, ch. 1, § 017.01, United States Cellular Corporation ("Applicant") seeks to amend its application by eliminating one project referred to as the Wallace project. Based upon its negotiations with Consolidated Telco, Inc., an Intervenor in this application, Applicant has decided to remove that project for consideration. In exchange for the withdrawal of the Wallace tower, Consolidated Telco, Inc. has agreed to withdraw its Formal Intervention in this docket.

Based on the statements made by Applicant in its Motion, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the Motion to Amend Petition should be granted.
