## Background

By Application filed November 26, 2014, Inventive Wireless of Nebraska, LLC d/b/a Vistabeam ("Vistabeam") seeks Nebraska Broadband Program ("NEBP") support. Notice of the Application appeared in the <u>Daily Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska on December 4, 2014.

A staff recommendation was filed on May 11, 2015. No prefiled testimony was filed for Vistabeam.

On July 6, 2015, the Commission held a public hearing on the application in Lincoln, Nebraska. For administrative efficiency, the hearing was consolidated with the hearings in NUSF-92.17, NUSF-92.19, NUSF-92.21, NUSF-92.23 through 92.30, NUSF-92.32, NUSF-92.33, and NUSF-92.35 through NUSF-92.40. No appearance was entered on behalf of the applicant.

The Commission staff analyzed each project including the projects filed by Vistabeam. For the reasons set forth in the Staff Recommendation which was received into the record as Exhibit No. 23, the recommendation did not include funding for the Vistabeam projects. Vistabeam did not contest the staff's recommendation. Accordingly, Vistabeam's application should be denied. The Commission encourages Vistabeam to file an application in subsequent rounds for support.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Application filed by Inventive Wireless of Nebraska, LLC d/b/a Vistabeam should be and it is hereby denied.
