On September 22, 2016, United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a CenturyLink filed a request for support of several broadband projects. Notice of the Application was published in the North Platte Telegraph on October 11, 2016, the Daily Record, Omaha, on October 12, 2016, and in the Business Farmer on October 14, 2016. A Protest was filed by Inventive Wireless of Nebraska LLC d/b/a Vistabeam on November 14, 2016. On November 3 and November 14, 2016, CenturyLink filed motions to amend and withdraw certain projects from its application. On January 10, 2017, those motions were granted.

At this time, the Commission finds it appropriate to schedule the application for hearing. The hearing will be held on **March 28, 2017**, at 11:00 a.m., in the Commission Hearing Room, 1200 N Street, 300 The Atrium, Lincoln, Nebraska 68508.
