#### BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 9, 2003, Kara J. Thielen, Director of the Nebraska Public Service Commission Wireless E911 Department, filed a complaint against Virgin Mobile for failure to timely remit surcharges to the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund.

On October 13, 2003, Virgin Mobile filed an answer to the complaint, stating that Virgin Mobile's surcharge remittances were untimely due to a misunderstanding with the consultants who prepare its state regulatory compliance filings.

On October 15, 2003, the complainant filed a motion to dismiss the application.

### OPINION AND FINDINGS

After due consideration of the motion and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. The motion should be granted.
- 2. The complaint in Docket No. 911-005/DC-64 should be dismissed.
