#### OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) hereby opens the above-captioned docket, on its own motion, to process wireless service provider requests for funding for Enhanced Wireless 911 implementation.

To date, funding requests from wireless service providers have been docketed separately as wireless service provider (WSP) dockets. Each new request for funding for a particular wireless service provider was given a new docket number.

For the sake of simplifying the system for docketing requests related to enhanced wireless 911, the Commission finds that all wireless service provider requests for funding shall be docketed and processed under the present docket. Each wireless service provider will be assigned a specific number under this docket (e.g. 911-022.1, 911.022.2, etc.) All funding requests made by that provider will be docketed under that number. Additionally, all previously approved funding requests for a particular wireless service provider will be incorporated into the new docket number assigned to that provider.

#### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the above-captioned docket be, and it is hereby, opened to process wireless service provider requests for funding for Enhanced Wireless 911 implementation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all new and previously approved wireless service provider funding requests shall be docketed as outlined herein.
