BY THE COMMISSION:

The Commission, on its own motion, scheduled a hearing on this matter pursuant to an order entered on October 24, 2007, to determine the annual surcharge for the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund (Fund), pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-458 (2006 Supp).

Notice of the hearing was sent to all Public Safety Answering Points and Wireless Service Providers on October 24, 2007. Notice of the hearing was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 20, 2007. The Commission held a hearing in this matter on November 27, 2007, in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-457, the surcharge may be increased by the Commission up to \$.70 per active telephone number or functional equivalent for all counties but Douglas County which remains capped at \$.50. Mr. Jeff Pursley, Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department, testified regarding the surcharge level and recommended that the surcharge remain at \$.50 statewide as there are sufficient funds to cover current and projected non recurring and recurring expenses.

Mr. Pursley testified that the surcharge, currently set at \$.50 per wireless access line per month, should remain at \$.50 statewide.

At its November 26, 2007 meeting, the Enhanced Wireless 911 Advisory Board also recommended that the surcharge remain at \$.50. No other evidence was presented during the hearing.

The Commission finds that based upon testimony provided by staff and the recommendation of the Advisory Board, the surcharge should remain at fifty cents per active telephone number or functional equivalent, per month.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the surcharge for the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund should be set at \$.50 per active telephone number or functional equivalent, per month.
