BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 28, 2003, the Commission opened this docket to provide for and fund intertandem trunking across the State of Nebraska for use in provision of wireless enhanced 911 service. Intertandem trunking has been completed between Council Bluffs, Iowa, to Des Moines, Iowa; Sioux City, South Dakota, to Council Bluffs, Iowa; Grand Island to Council Bluffs, Iowa; and Lincoln to Council Bluffs, Iowa. Payments have been made in the amount of \$832,974.68 to Qwest and \$79,373.16 to Alltel, now known as Windstream, to complete these connections.

On February 23, 2010, the Commission entered an order in Docket No. 911-019/PI-118 establishing a permanent funding mechanism and process for future funding of costs of implementation and provision of wireless enhanced 911 service. Additionally, in Docket No. 911-040/PI-152, the Commission applied for and was awarded federal grant funds. One project designated for federal grant funding was the completion of intertandem trunking throughout the state.

The federal grant funding requires certain tracking and reporting. The Commission finds that a separate docket should be opened in order to conduct the remaining portions of the intertandem trunking project and ensure compliance with all grant requirements. Therefore, the present docket is no longer necessary and should be closed.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that this docket shall be and is hereby closed.
