BY THE COMMISSION:

The Commission, on its own motion, opened this docket by Order entered October 8, 2002, to determine whether it should obtain metrics data reports in order to monitor performance of various aspects of wireless enhanced 911 service. The reports were requested to assist the Commission, wireless carriers, and PSAPs to ascertain and remedy misrouted calls.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

It is the belief of the Commission that this docket should be closed. Concerns have been raised as to the accuracy and completeness of the data obtained from the metrics data reports, as well as privacy concerns regarding the release of the reports to the Commission. Subsequently, the Commission entered Docket 911-025/PI-120 on August 15, 2006, to address these concerns as well as the funding mechanism for PSAP equipment. Orders related to this docket with respect to call metrics data were suspended pending the outcome of the subsequent docket. Because the subsequent order was entered, this docket is no longer necessary.

For the reasons stated above, The Commission finds that this docket should be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the above-captioned docket be, and is hereby closed.
