### BY THE COMMISSION:

T-Mobile of Bellevue, Washington, is a wireless carrier that has cell towers in Nebraska, but does not currently have a home calling area that covers any part of the state and is not currently selling service in Nebraska. T-Mobile therefore does not have any local NXX codes to assign for use as pseudo Automatic Number Identification numbers (pANIs), which are necessary in order to provide Phase I wireless enhanced 911 service.

Qwest Corporation, a local exchange carrier serving in Nebraska, has informally indicated to Commission staff that it has numbers available, and is willing to share them with T-Mobile, provided that T-Mobile be responsible for the costs and liability associated with using the numbers. Qwest has informally requested that the Commission be responsible for administering and assigning the numbers to T-Mobile. On October 24, 2003, Qwest provided to the Commission a letter consenting to allow T-Mobile to use the 402-511 NXX for the purposes stated in this order.

### O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

In the interest of providing T-Mobile's customers with access to Phase I enhanced 911 where available, the Commission finds it should propose to administer numbers provided by Qwest for use as pANIs for T-Mobile, with T-Mobile assuming liability and costs for use of the numbers. The Commission would be responsible for assigning numbers to T-Mobile as needed.

### O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the policy described above is hereby adopted.









