On, August 30, 2005, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) opened the above-captioned docket, on its own motion, to investigate issues related to the calculation and reimbursement of costs to carriers of implementing enhanced wireless 911 service.

The Commission has received written comments from interested parties on the issues outlined in the August 30, 2005 order.

The Commission requested written comment from all interested parties including, but not limited to, wireless carriers, local exchange carriers (LECs), and any third-party vendors on the following issues related to the cost of enhanced wireless 911 service in Nebraska.

The Commission has scheduled this matter for public hearing for **2:30 p.m., December 6, 2005** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, to solicit further public and industry comment on the issues related to the calculation and reimbursement of wireless enhanced 911 costs.

Parties unable to attend are welcome to submit written testimony prior to the hearing. The hearing will be conducted in a legislative format.
