OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) opened this docket on its own motion June 6, 2006, seeking to establish audit requirements related to the Wireless Enhanced 911 Fund. On 10, 2007, the Commission entered an Order remittance policies and establishing a waiver mechanism for certain qualifying carriers. On September 30, 2008, the Commission entered an Order modifying and clarifying the remittance policy and waiver mechanism with respect to the Nebraska Universal Service Fund (NUSF). This Order addresses a waiver request filed by T-Mobile for the audit due on December 31, 2008.

The Commission finds that T-Mobile Central, LLC has met all criteria designated by the Commission in its September 30, 2008, Order and accordingly should be granted a waiver for the E911 remittance audit otherwise due on December 31, 2008.
