On May 25, 2010, Sue Vanicek, Director of the Nebraska Telephone Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (Complainant), filed a complaint in this docket alleging a violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-437. Complainant alleged Respondents failed to timely file with the Commission annual reporting information as required by § 86-437(2) by April 30, 2010. Complainant sought an order assessing administrative fines and ordering Respondents to comply with the reporting requirements.

Certain Respondents have been and will likely be dismissed from this complaint. However, a hearing will be necessary regarding any remaining Respondents.
