On May 17, 2011, Sue Vanicek, Director of the Nebraska Telephone Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (Complainant), filed a complaint in this docket alleging a violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-437. Complainant alleged Respondents failed to timely file with the Commission annual reporting information as required by § 86-437(2) by April 30, 2011. Complainant sought an order assessing administrative fines and ordering Respondents to comply with the reporting requirements.

Respondents listed below have signed a stipulation with Complainant wherein Respondents have agreed to pay an administrative fine and costs to dismiss the departmental complaint:

stipulations and payment are satisfactory and therefore the abovelisted Respondents should be dismissed from the complaint.

The companies listed in the preceding paragraph should be aware that this Commission will not tolerate similar behavior in 2012 regarding the filing of the 2011 report. If reports are not postmarked on or before April 30, 2012, the option of resolving the complaint through a stipulation will be closely scrutinized. All companies that have agreed to such a stipulation will be considered a willful violator and be subject to the maximum penalty allowed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Cozad Telephone Company, Dark Fiber Solutions, Inc., and McLeod USA Telecommunications Services/Paetec Business Services, be, and are hereby, dismissed from the complaint.
