## BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 27, 2006, Jeff Pursley, Director of the Nebraska Telephone Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (Complainant) filed a complaint against the above-captioned Respondents alleging violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-437 (Cum. Supp. 2004). The Commission further finds that Respondents should be ordered to show cause as to why administrative fines should not be assessed and an order should not be entered requiring their compliance with § 86-437. Furthermore, the Commission finds that a hearing should be scheduled on this matter.
