BY THE COMMISSION:

Convey f/k/a Telemetrix, Boulder, Colorado (Convey) has filed a Phase I Implementation Plan pursuant to the Enhanced Wireless 911 Services Act Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-442 to 86-469 (2006 Cum. Supp.) (the Act), 291 Neb. Admin. Code, Chapter 1, Section 5, and Progression Order No. 5 in Commission Docket No. 911-001, entered July 16, 2002. Convey is not seeking any funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund to provide enhanced wireless 911 service for Phase I or Phase II implementation.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Convey has submitted an implementation plan in compliance with Commission Docket No. 911-001. The Commission is of the opinion and finds that Convey's Implementation Plan should be approved.

Convey shall provide to the Commission quarterly as required by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-459 (2006 Cum. Supp.).

The Commission further finds that Convey is not seeking funding at this time. Should Convey wish to request funding in the future, it should file with the Commission a request pursuant to the Act and Admin. Code, Chapter 1, Section 5, and Progression Order No. 5 in Commission Docket No. 911-001 entered July 16, 2002.
