By written requests for funding received February 15, 2007, Sarpy County sought funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses of implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service. Among other GIS related items, the request includes in-house recurring administrative costs related to the maintenance of GIS data in the amount of **\$1,293.60 per month** for ten (10) hours per week of maintenance on the map data layers and an additional fifteen (15) hours per week for general map maintenance in the amount of **\$1,243.60 per month**.

The Enhanced Wireless 911 Advisory Board considered these requests at its March 23, 2007 meeting. A motion to approve the request failed. Due to the nature of the funding requested and the action of the Advisory Board, the Commission finds that this matter should be set for hearing on **July 10, 2007 at 1:30 p.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.
