BY THE COMMISSION:

By written request for funding dated February 14, 2007, Furnas County, Kearney, sought funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses for implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service. In particular, Furnas County seeks funding for the purchase and installation of equipment.

On May 23, 2007, the Commission entered an order granting the request in part but denying the request with respect to costs in excess of the vendor's response to the Commission's Request for Proposal (RFP). The amount in excess of the RFP totaled \$8,523.60. Pursuant to the May 23, 2007 Order, Furnas County has requested a hearing on those portions of its funding request that were denied.

The Commission originally set the hearing for July 10, 2007 at 2:00 p.m. A letter was received from Furnas County E911 office that they will not be able to attend the hearing at the scheduled date, and requested that the hearing be rescheduled for a later date.

The Commission finds that this matter should be reset for hearing on **August 7, 2007 at 1:30 p.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.
