BY THE COMMISSION:

The Commission entered an order in Docket PSAP-025.1 on July 18, 2006 approving non-recurring and recurring charges for the purchase, installation, maintenance of equipment and software necessary to implement enhanced wireless 911 service. Although the request for funding was originally filed and disposed of in Docket No. PSAP-025.1, it was incorporated herein by the order entered on August 8, 2006 in Docket No. 911-023.

The approved recurring charges of \$1,367.38 were for costs associated with software and hardware maintenance. However, these costs will not be incurred by Lincoln County until the one-year warranty period on its equipment expires. Installation of the equipment was completed on June 1, 2006.

Therefore, the Commission amends its July 18, 2006 order to approve payment of the \$1,367.38 in recurring charges commencing June 1, 2007.

The Fund shall therefore pay to Lincoln County the amount of \$75,099.06 in non-recurring costs immediately and \$1,367.38 per month in recurring costs commencing June 1, 2007.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that its July 18, 2006 order in Docket PSAP-025.1 is amended as set forth herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund shall pay to Lincoln County the amount of \$75,099.06 in non-recurring costs immediately and \$1,367.38 per month in recurring costs commencing June 1, 2007.
