On or about March 23, 2009, Clay County, Edgar (Clay County) filed a funding request seeking approval for costs for equipment and software necessary for the provision of enhanced wireless 911 services to be paid from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund (Fund).

Clay County had previously requested that the request be suspended. The Enhanced Wireless 911 Advisory Board considered the request at its April 6, 2009 meeting and recommended funding be approved. The Commission has previously approved funding for equipment for Clay County. Therefore, this funding request would be the second request for equipment received from Clay County.

Based upon the above and in light of the upcoming implementation of the permanent funding mechanism, the Commission finds that this matter should be set for hearing on **January 12, 2010 at 1:30 p.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.




