#### BY THE COMMISSION:

By written request for funding received March 23, 2009, Clay County, Edgar, seeks funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses for implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service.

In its request, Clay County seeks \$102,420.00 for the purchase and installation of equipment and associated software for the provision of enhanced wireless 911 service. The Commission previously provided funding in the amount of \$102,420.00 for equipment in 2007.

The Enhanced Wireless 911 Advisory Board considered the funding request at its April 6, 2009 meeting and recommended that the request be approved based upon the wireless/landline allocation factor established in Docket No. 911-017/PI-116.

Because this request would represent a second purchase of equipment for the county it presents a policy question that must be resolved pursuant to the permanent funding mechanism being developed in Docket No. 911-019/PI-118.

### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Clay County's funding request be suspended, pending completion of the permanent funding mechanism pursuant to Docket No. 911-019/PI-118.
