BY THE COMMISSION:

By written request for funding dated February 12, 2007, Box Butte County, Public Safety Answering Point, Alliance, sought funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses for implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service. On May 15, 2007, the Commission entered an order approving funding in part in the amount of **\$130,497.21** for equipment. Additionally, the Commission approved **\$31,553.38** for Evergreen software maintenance and **\$27,349.52** for hardware maintenance paid in annual installments for a period of up to five (5) years subject to the limitations set forth in the May 15, 2007 order and the terms of the contract, subject to change based upon the availability of funding and the permanent funding mechanism.

Due to a clerical error amounts approved for maintenance were listed incorrectly in one paragraph of the order. The Commission enters the present Order Nunc Pro Tunc to clarify that the amounts listed above are the correct amounts approved for the hardware and software maintenance. The remaining terms of the May 15, 2007 order remain in full force and effect.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Fund shall pay **\$31,553.38** for Evergreen software maintenance and **\$27,349.52** for hardware maintenance paid in annual installments for a period of up to five (5) years subject to the limitations set forth herein and the terms of the contract, subject to change based upon the availability of funding and the permanent funding mechanism.


