BY THE COMMISSION:

By written request for funding received February 6, 2007, Johnson County Public Safety Answering Point, Tecumseh seeks funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses of implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service. In particular, Johnson County seeks funding for Vesta Pallas equipment and MapStar software for the provision of Phase II 911 service.

Certain costs related to the equipment were in excess of Plant/CML's response to the Commission's Request for Proposal (RFP). Additionally, Johnson County has entered into a lease agreement for the equipment which gives rise to several questions regarding the terms of payment.

The Commission originally set a hearing date for July 10, 2007, at 1:30 p.m. A letter was received from the Johnson County Sheriff that indicated they would not be able to attend the hearing at that time, and requested that the hearing be rescheduled for a later date.

The Commission finds that in order to properly review the funding request submitted, this matter should be re-set for hearing on **August 7, 2007 at 1:30 p.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.
