BY THE COMMISSION:

By written request for funding received January 14, 2008, Sheridan County, Rushville, sought funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses to implement and provide enhanced wireless 911 service. In its application, Sheridan County sought non-recurring costs in the amount of **\$94,255.00** for the purchase and installation of equipment and **\$14,645.00** for equipment maintenance for five (5) years paid in annual installments. An order was entered on June 24, 2008 approving **\$89,255.00** of the costs for equipment and software and the **\$14,645.00** in maintenance. The remaining **\$5,000.00** was not approved as it related to reporting software for which the Commission does not provide funding.

On or about February 25, 2009, Sheridan County submitted a new funding request seeking **\$5,000.00** for annual support. However, all documentation received indicated that the \$5,000.00 related not to annual maintenance, but to the **\$5,000.00** unpaid on the invoice for reporting software previously denied by the Commission.

Based upon the documentation received and the fact that the amount in question was previously denied by the Commission, the Commission finds that the February 25, 2009 funding request should be denied.

Should Sheridan County wish to be heard by the Commission regarding the funding request not approved herein, it shall notify the Commission in writing **within fifteen (15) days** of this order and the matter will be set for hearing. Sheridan County would be required to present evidence to show that the **\$5,000.00** is for maintenance or another eligible cost.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the funding request is denied.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that should Sheridan County wish to be heard by the Commission regarding the denial of this funding request, it shall notify the Commission in writing **within fifteen (15) days** of this order and the matter will be set for hearing.
