BY THE COMMISSION:

By written request for funding dated February 15, 2007, Thurston County, Pender, sought funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses for implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service. On November 6, 2007, the Commission entered an order approving funding in the amount of **\$125,969.81** of which **\$110,969.81** was listed as non recurring costs for equipment. However, due to a typographical error, the amount approved should have read **\$119,936.63**, of which **\$104,936.63** was attributable to non recurring costs for equipment.

Therefore the Commission enters this order nunc pro tunc to correct the error and reflect the proper amount of **\$119,936.63** to be paid to Thurston County, or its designee, consistent with the terms of the November 6, 2007 order.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the November 6, 2007 order be corrected as set forth above and the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund shall pay to Thurston County or its designee the amount of **\$119,936.63** consistent with the terms of the November 6, 2007 order.
