## BY THE COMMISSION:

By written request for funding received January 8, 2010, Frontier County, Curtis, (Frontier County) seeks funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund (Fund) for implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service.

In its application, Frontier County seeks non-recurring costs in the amount of \$1,375.00 for one (1) year software maintenance commencing December 1, 2009. Frontier County has entered into a contract with GeoComm, Inc. (GeoComm) for the maintenance of GeoLynx software and has provided a copy of the contract with its request for funding.

The Enhanced Wireless 911 Advisory Board considered Frontier County's request at its March 15, 2010, meeting and recommended that the Commission approve payment in full. All amounts requested are consistent with GeoComm's response to the Commission's RFP as amended and approved by the Commission on June 24, 2008, in Docket No. 911-011/PI-79. In its contract with GeoComm, Frontier County authorizes the Nebraska Public Service Commission to remit payments directly to the vendor.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

This request for additional funding is being processed pursuant to  $\underline{\text{Neb}}$ .  $\underline{\text{Rev}}$ .  $\underline{\text{Stat}}$ .  $\underline{\text{SS}}$  86-442 to 86-470. (Cum. Supp. 2006), 291 Neb. Admin. Code, Chapter 1, Section 5, Progression Order No. 5 in Commission Docket No. 911-001, entered July 16, 2002, and the Interim Policy established in Progression Order No. 1 in Commission Docket No. 911-017/PI-116, entered February 13, 2007 (Interim Policy).

Costs requested are eligible under  $\underline{\text{Neb}}$ .  $\underline{\text{Rev}}$ .  $\underline{\text{Stat}}$ . § 86-465 (2006 Supp.). All costs have been incurred or will be incurred for the provision of Phase II wireless enhanced 911 service.

The Commission finds that payment should be made to GeoComm in the amount of \$1,375.00 pursuant to the terms of the contract for non-recurring costs for software support.

Approval of all amounts is subject to the limitations set forth herein.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the request for funding of Frontier County shall be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission shall remit to GeoComm from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund \$1,375.00 for non-recurring costs as described herein.
