BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 18, 2007, the Commission entered an order approving a funding request filed by Hitchcock County, Public Safety Answering Point, Trenton, (Hitchcock County) seeking funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses for implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service.

In its application, Hitchcock County sought non-recurring costs in the amount of **\$31,940.00** for the development of GIS data, cell sector creation and associated project management services; **\$14,500.00** for the purchase and installation of and training on map display software; an additional **\$2,750.00** for software support services. Additionally, Hitchcock County seeks **\$18,900.00** paid in three (3) annual installments of \$6,300.00 for three (3) years of GIS data maintenance services.

Due to a clerical error, the order misstated the amount actually intended to be approved. Therefore, the Commission finds that the December 18, 2007 order should be amended. The amounts approved in the order should be amended as follows. Payments should have been made to Hitchcock County, or its designee, in the amount of **\$46,440.00** in non-recurring costs for development and project management services related to the creation of GIS data; in the amount of **\$2,750.00** for software support services; and **\$18,900.00** paid in three (3) annual installments of **\$6,300.00** for GIS data maintenance.

All other portions of the original December 18, 2007 order remain in effect.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund shall pay to Hitchcock County, or its designee, consistent with the terms of this order, in the amounts reflected herein to the extent payment has not already been made.
