BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

By written request for funding received December 8, 2008, Dundy County, Benkelman, (Dundy County) seeks funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund (Fund) for implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service.

In its application, Dundy County seeks non-recurring costs in the amount of **\$113,388.00** for the purchase and installation of equipment necessary for enhanced wireless 911 service. Additionally, Dundy County seeks funding for four years maintenance totaling **\$14,868.00** paid in equal annual installments.

Pursuant to Neb. Admin. Code, Title 291, Ch. 1, § 5, Progression Order No. 5 in Commission Docket No. 911-001, entered July 16, 2002 PSAPs must have all equipment needed to operate landline enhanced 911 and the capability to receive data prior to receiving funding. Dundy County has not satisfied these requirements. Therefore, the Hearing Officer finds that a hearing is necessary to determine whether said requirements should be waived.
