BY THE COMMISSION:

By written request for funding received from Morrill County, Bridgeport, seeking funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund (Fund) for equipment and software necessary for the implementation of Phase II wireless enhanced 911.

In its application, Morrill County seeks non-recurring costs in the amount of **\$169,580.00** for the purchase and installation of equipment and software necessary for enhanced wireless 911 service. Additionally, Morrill County seeks funding for five (5) years maintenance on both the equipment and software totaling **\$24,604.00** paid in annual installments to each vendor.

Pursuant to Neb. Admin. Code, Title 291, Ch. 1, § 5, Progression Order No. 5 in Commission Docket No. 911-001, entered July 16, 2002 PSAPs must have all equipment needed to operate landline enhanced 911 and the capability to receive data prior to receiving funding for equipment and software. Based upon the information available at this time, it appears that Morrill County has not satisfied these requirements. Therefore, the Commission finds that a hearing is necessary to determine whether said requirements should be waived.

A hearing on this matter is scheduled on **November 10, 2009 at 2:00 p.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.
