BY THE COMMISSION:

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

The Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department ("Department") of the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") and United Cellular Operating Company of Greater Iowa, Inc., d/b/a US Cellular ("US Cellular") discovered that possible violations of wireless tower testing requirements set forth in Application No. 911-001/PI-52, Progression Order No. 5 (July 16, 2002) ("Progression Order No. 5"). Although US Cellular asserts that it has conducted all required testing, it is unable to demonstrate that it provided notice to the Commission of such testing prior to activating wireless enhanced 911 service for several towers and that failure to provide notice is a violation of Progression Order No. 5.

Therefore, the parties have entered into a stipulation in order to avoid the necessity of a departmental complaint and subsequent hearing. Pursuant to the stipulation, certain towers will be retested and US Cellular has agreed to pay a fine and administrative costs.

The Commission, being fully advised, finds that the stipulation should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that stipulation in the above-referenced docket is hereby approved.
