OPINION AND FINDINGS

On January 27, 2009, Sue Vanicek, Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (NTIPS) (hereinafter "Complainant") of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) filed a Complaint against Convergia, Inc., Pointe-Claire, Quebec, Canada, (hereinafter "Respondent") alleging that Respondent failed to timely file its Quarterly Report due January 15, 2009, pursuant to Neb.
