OPINION AND FINDINGS

On May 15, 2007, Jeffrey L. Pursley, Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (NTIPS) (hereinafter "Complainant") of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) filed a Complaint against Sagir, Inc., Ithaca, New York (hereinafter "Respondent") alleging that Respondent failed to file its wireless E911 remittance worksheets or remittance payments to the NTIPS department for September 2006, December 2006 and January 2007 pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-442 et seq. (Cum. Supp. 2006).

Since the filing of the complaint, Respondent has filed the appropriate worksheets and/or payments and signed a stipulation agreeing to the payment of a fine and administrative costs. Respondent has paid the fine and administrative costs. Respondent is on notice that should it fail to timely make future filings that additional administrative fines and costs may be imposed.

The Commission finds that the stipulation should be approved and that the Complaint should be dismissed against Respondent. Respondent is released from any further proceedings in relation to Application No. 911-033.01.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Complaint in Application No. 911-033.01 is hereby dismissed and that the stipulation is approved.
