OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 21, 2008, Sue Vanicek, Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (NTIPS) of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) (hereinafter "Complainant") for Complaint against I-Wireless, LLC, Newport, Kentucky (hereinafter "Respondent") alleging that Respondent failed to file its wireless E911 remittance worksheets or remittance payments to the NTIPS department for January, 2008; March, 2008; April, 2008; May, 2008; and June, 2008 pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-442 et seq. (2008 Supp.).

Since the filing of the complaint, Respondent has filed the worksheets and/or payments and informed appropriate Commission that steps are being taken to ensure that future made on a timely basis. filings will be Additionally, Respondent has requested a waiver of fines. Pursuant to Commission policy, Respondent is entitled to a one-time waiver. Respondent is on notice that should it fail to timely make future filings that additional administrative fines and costs may be imposed.

The Commission finds that the one-time waiver should be approved and that the Complaint should be dismissed against Respondent. Respondent is released from any further proceedings in relation to Application No. 911-033.05.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Complaint in Application No. 911-033.05 is hereby dismissed.
