## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On July 28, 2009, Sue Vanicek, Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (NTIPS) (hereinafter "Complainant") of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) filed a Complaint against Cozac Wireless dba Movida Communications (hereinafter "Respondent") alleging that Respondent failed to timely file its wireless E911 remittance worksheets or remittance payments to the NTIPS department for March and April 2009 pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-442 et seq. (Cum. Supp. 2008).

Since the filing of the complaint, it appears that Respondent is no longer providing service in Nebraska. At this time, it appears that Respondent has filed bankruptcy.

The Commission finds that the Complaint is dismissed without prejudice.
