OPINION AND FINDINGS

On January 12, 2010, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) opened the above-captioned docket, on its own motion, to investigate issues associated with Plant CML equipment and maintenance. The Commission sought comment from interested parties. Comments were filed on behalf of the Columbus-Platte County E-911 Technical Committee, the Holdrege Police Department E911 Dispatch and GeoComm.

The investigation was originally opened in response to complaints by Custer County outlined in a December 29, 2009, regarding its Plant CML products in order to determine whether problems experienced by Custer County are isolated or are being experienced by other PSAPs utilizing the platform.

The comments received with further correspondence from Custer County, indicated that the problems experienced were not widespread and are currently being addressed.

The Commission finds that this investigation should be closed and no further action be taken at this time. The Commission reserves the right to reopen an investigation should any problems develop in the future.
