OPINION AND FINDINGS

On or about June 22, 2010, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) approved funding for Merrick County pursuant to the the permanent funding mechanism approved under Docket No. 911-019/PI-118.

The order correctly stated that Merrick County was eligible for funding in the amount of \$29,639.61 for the 2010-11 funding year and that prior funding commitments in the amount of \$1,444.00 were previously approved and must be deducted from the allocation. However, due to a clerical error the final total amount of funding was incorrectly stated as it failed to reflect the prior funding commitments.

Therefore, the Commission finds that the June 22, 2010 order should be corrected to reflect that funding is approved for Merrick County in the amount of \$28,195.61 consistent with the allocation determined in Docket 911-019/PI-118.

The remainder of the June 22, 2010 order remains in full effect.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the June 22, 2010 order should be corrected to reflect that funding is approved for Merrick County in the amount of \$28,195.61 consistent with the allocation determined in Docket 911-019/PI-118.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that remainder of the June 22, 2010 order remains in full effect.
