OPINION AND FINDINGS

On or about September 7, 2010, the Chairman of the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners filed a request on behalf of Hamilton County that it be permitted to use funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund to pay for personnel costs for an inhouse department for the maintenance of Geographical Information Systems (GIS) data beginning in 2012. The April 6, 2010 Progression Order No. 1 in Docket No. 911-019/PI-118 specifically provides that with the exception of Douglas, Sarpy and Lancaster Counties, money from the Fund cannot be used to support personnel costs including those related to in-house GIS services.

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) requested additional information regarding the qualifications of the individuals employed by the department. On or about October 4, 2010, Hamilton County provided a letter in response.

On April 7, 2010, the Hamilton County Sheriff's Department (Hamilton County) filed its application for funding with the Commission pursuant to Docket No. 911-019/PI-118.
