BY THE COMMISSION:

On or about October 7, 2016, Saline County filed a request to use set aside funds for the purchase of an upgraded GeoComm web-based mapping system, in the amount of \$27,279.00. In addition to one time charges, the request includes \$3,400 per year for maintenance on the GeoComm mapping software.

The costs are shared costs subject to the wireless/wireline ratio. The wireless ratio for Saline County for the 2016-2017 funding year is 83% wireless.

The Wireless Enhanced 911 Advisory Board considered the request at its October 26, 2016 meeting and recommended the request be approved.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) adopted the permanent cost model to administer funding for public safety answering points for the implementation and provision of Enhanced Wireless 911 service under Docket No. 911-019/PI-118.

Based upon the request for funding, supporting documentation, and in consideration of the recommendation of the Advisory Board, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the costs requested to purchase the mapping upgrade are eligible under NEB. REV. STAT. § 86-465 as costs have been incurred or will be incurred for the purchase, installation, maintenance or operation of telecommunications equipment and telecommunications services required for the provision of enhanced wireless 911 service.

The amount eligible for funding using set-aside funds would be up to **\$22,641.57** when utilizing the wireless ratio on file with the Commission.

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Based upon the above, the Commission finds that use of set-aside funding by Saline County should be approved in the amount of up to **\$22,641.57**. Annual maintenance amounts should be paid with annually allocated funds and not set-aside funds.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the funding request for Saline County is hereby approved as set forth above.
