BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On or about October 8, 2015, Cuming County filed a request to use enhanced wireless 911 set-aside funds toward the upgrade of call taking equipment to Zetron Max in the amount of \$141,561. On January 12, 2016, the Commission entered an order denying Cuming County's funding request.¹ In the order, the Commission stated that Cuming County could request a one-time waiver for good cause. On January 16, 2016, Cuming County submitted its waiver request via email.


